GUNNISON BORN & RAISED CATTLE CLASS

The intention of the Gunnison Born and Raised Cattle Class is to encourage youth to show cattle that are born and raised in the Gunnison Basin. The Gunnison County Stockgrowers Association annually sponsor the awards for the Gunnison Born and Raised class as a way of giving recognition to area cattle producers while also recognizing youth for selecting and raising locally born cattle.

Requirements to participate in the Gunnison Born and Raised class:

- *Animal must be physically born within the Gunnison Basin
- *Animal must be physically fed and raised in the Gunnison Basin
- *Animal must reside within the Gunnison Basin from birth until participating in the Gunnison Born and Raised class

These rules allow for the exception of showing the animal out of the Gunnison Basin no longer than 7 days per show and, allows the animal to be treated out of the Gunnison Basin for medical reasons.

If for any reason the animal is out of the Gunnison Basin for more than 7 consecutive days between birth and showing in this class, the participant needs to notify the President of the Gunnison Stockgrowers Association of the reason so that the association can make a determination of eligibility. Contact the Extension Office for the current President.
