Dear Colorado Fuel User:

The State of Colorado is aware that the Blue Mesa Bridge closure is affecting fuel users who may have a need to use clear diesel for exempt purposes. Fuel users that qualify for the Exempt Fuel Use Refund program will receive a percentage of fuel taxes paid for clear diesel and other fuel types purchased and is used in an exempt manner. Claims must be for a minimum of 20 gallons of tax paid fuel (i.e. dyed diesel does not qualify) and submitted within one year of the date of purchase.

Submit applications using the Gasoline/Special Fuel Tax Refund Permit Application, [form DR 7189](#). Applications may be submitted electronically by emailing [DOR fueltax@state.co.us](mailto:DOR_fueltax@state.co.us) or mailed to the address above.

To claim a refund, you must complete the Fuel Tax Refund Claim, [form DR 7118](#). Claims may be submitted quarterly via Colorado.gov/RevenueOnline. The first claim requires receipts for qualified gallons and may be filed with your application. The Department may periodically request receipts to verify refund claims.

Claims submitted through Colorado.gov/RevenueOnline are processed faster than claims submitted by paper. Once the application has been accepted, a Revenue Online account can be created using the letter ID on the Refund Permit Approval letter.
